

Nutcracker Rehearsal Schedule 2021

It is expected that if you are in The Nutcracker that you will participate fully by attending ALL REHEARSALS AND ALL PERFORMANCES. It is not fair to the other dancers to be irresponsible in rehearsal attendance or not present at all the performances. We are also teaching proper stage etiquette and responsibility. Please make the commitment and comply with this. Those dancers having multiple Sat. or Sun. rehearsals who miss more than 2 rehearsal will be replaced: This includes the party scene, soldier scenes, Lamb Chops, and other dances. Dancers who have only one or two weekend rehearsals may not miss a weekend rehearsal!

* Everyone is responsible for checking this rehearsal schedule thoroughly. Do not expect your instructor to remind you of rehearsals. All understudies are expected to attend all rehearsals for their parts. No exceptions. All dancers attending rehearsals on weekends should be fifteen minutes early so that you can warm-up!!! If you don't do this it will make all the rehearsals following yours late for that day! YOU MUST WARM UP!!!
